## Year 7 Geography Hengistbury Head Fieldtrip

Year 7 Geography students will soon be studying the Coasts topic as part of their Learning Journey, which is a key topic throughout their learning and features at both GCSE and A-Level. As we live in such a beautiful area in terms of beaches, we want students to link their local area to the concepts we are studying in class. The students will also learn key skills that are useful not only for their Geography learning journey, but also in future careers. I am therefore pleased to be able to offer your child the opportunity to extend their learning by visiting Hengistbury Head on Monday 17<sup>th</sup> or Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> June 2024:

- **7Ge1/x (Mr Chant's class) will be split across the two days – your teacher will let you know which day you will be attending.**

The trip will take place on Monday 17th June for Geography groups:

- 7Ge2/x (Mr Davies class)
- 7Ge2/y (Mr Davies class)
- 7Ge1/y (Mr Chant's class)
- 7Ge3/x (Mrs Potter/Mr Houghton's class)

and the trip will take place on Tuesday 18th June for Geography groups:

- 7Ge1/z (Mr Coyle/Mr Houghton's class)
- 7Ge2/z (Mr Coyle's class)
- 7Ge3/y (Mrs Potter/Mr Davies class)
- 7Ge3/z (Mr Houghton's class)

The schedule for each day will be as follows:

### Monday 17th June

- 7Ge2/x and 7Ge2/y will leave school at 8.30am and return to school at approx. 11.30am in time for normal lessons in Period 3, 4 and 5.
- 7Ge1/y and 7Ge3/x will leave school at 11.00am and return to school in time for normal transport at 3.05pm. They will need a packed lunch.
- **Half of 7Ge1/x will be split across the first and second sessions. Your child's class teacher (Mr Chant) will let your child know which session they will join.**

### Tuesday 18th June

- 7Ge1/z and 7Ge2/z will leave school at 8.30am and return to school at approx. 11.30am in time for normal lessons in Period 3, 4 and 5.
- 7Ge3/y and 7Ge3/z will leave school at 11.00am and return to school in time for normal transport at 3.05pm. They will need a packed lunch.
- **Half of 7Ge1/x will be split across the first and second sessions. Your child's class teacher (Mr Chant) will let your child know which session they will join.**

**Please note that students leaving at 8.30am will need to meet at the front of school at 8.20am. They do not need to go to tutor. Students leaving at 11.00am will leave AFTER period 2/start of break.**

All students will be back in school for the end of the school day, please make sure that they are wearing suitable clothing for the day i.e. non-school uniform but jeans/shorts, jumper etc. are acceptable. Please check the weather before the day as students may need to wear and take sun cream/bring a sun hat. They should also bring the necessary writing equipment to make notes and record data from the fieldwork – this will include a pen, pencil and ruler. Students will also need to make sure they have their class books for the rest of their school day when they are not at Hengistbury Head. **Please ensure your child has enough food/drink for the day. Depending on logistics for the day, there may be an opportunity for students to buy an ice cream from the café.**

The cost of this visit is **£7.50** per student, which covers the cost of transport to and from Hengistbury Head, resources and insurances. Payment should be made using the school's on-line WisePay facility. Receipts are generated automatically on WisePay and sent to the email address you supply when making the payment.

If you would like your child to take part, please complete the attached medical consent form and **return to your child's Geography teacher by Friday 24<sup>th</sup> May 2024.** If you do not hand the form in by this date, your child may not be able to attend this trip.
