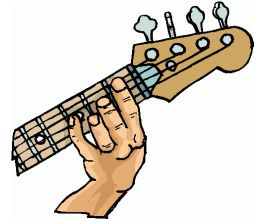

How to find us: From the A338 Spur Road, follow the signs for Bournemouth International Airport. Pass the airport entrance on your right, continue along the perimeter road and just before the end of the airfield, as the road bends round to the right, follow the brown sign for Parley Golf Centre and take the turning on your left into Parley Green Lane. If you're travelling from the Ferndown direction, at Parley crossroads follow the signs for the airport, take the second exit at the roundabout onto the airport perimeter road and take the first turning right into Parley Green Lane.
