The Lighthouse is a great opportunity for making new friends and becoming part of the local music scene, come and see what it is about at the festival.

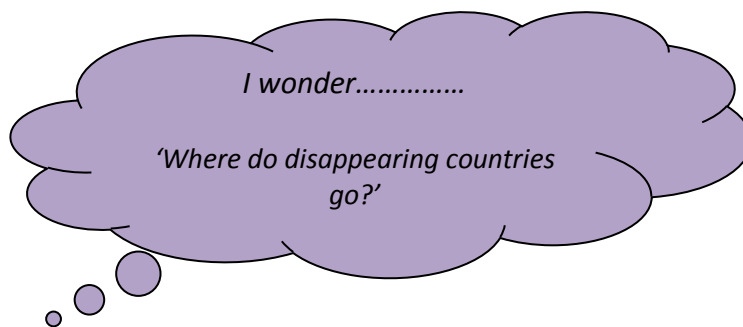
Literacy Focus

**How to join your local club in time for the
Rugby World Cup 2015**

'The Big Walk' – Thursday 16th July 2015

"We will be walking for those who can't."

We are all looking forward to 'The Big Walk' on Thursday 16th July 2015 and just want to remind you about the arrangements for the day.

The timing of the day will be approximately:

8.30am Student registration in tutor groups

8.30 onwards Students transported to the 'Big Walk'

9.45am Staff lead walkers depart with groups of students

11.00am Staff sweepers leave to close down the walk

We anticipate that the walk should be completed **by 2.15pm**. Students will be returned to school by bus, from where they will be dismissed at **3.05pm**.

Upon arriving at the start of the walk, you need to register with the member of staff, detailed below, who is responsible for signing your walk permit, which you will receive at this point. You should hand in your sponsorship form upon registering.

Year 8 – Mrs Riley / Mr Evans

Year 9 – Mrs Coombs / Mr Goddard

Your permit **must be stamped at each checkpoint**. At the finish of the walk the permits will be collected and the students signed off the walk. Sponsorship forms will then be re-issued to all participants.

Essentials for the day will include:

- **Sponsorship form – (please complete the details inside the form)**
- Suitable footwear to be able to walk 10km
- Appropriate clothing – waterproofs, hat, etc.
- Water
- Packed lunch (students in receipt of free school meals will be provided with a lunch at the start of the walk)
- Sun cream
- A map of the walk (issued on the day)

Students may bring a small sum of money with them to purchase ice cream or drinks at the end of the walk – time permitting.
